Harrods 'Petit Chai' from France

We have selected a red and white wine from the Vaucluse district in the Rhône Valley for the Harrods own-label 'bag-in-box'. These wines are packed in France exclusively under our own mark — Harrods 'Petit Chai'. We consider the quality to be the best available for this type of pack, a claim supported by Decanter Magazine selecting them as 'Wine of the Month' in their September 1982 issue.

The Vaucluse vineyards produce some of France's most famous wines. It is not surprising, therefore, that the more modest wines grown in the area represent such excellent value.

Vins de Pays du Vaucluse are made from famous grape varieties: Grenache and Carignan for the red; and Ugni-Blanc, Clairette and Grenache Blanc for the white.
