A small company with a big reputation, Ca' del Bosco of the Franciacorta wine area northeast of Milan, has taken a course directly opposite of that chosen by Cavit. Ca' del Bosco is known to connoisseurs everywhere for its superb sparkling wine but in the next few months it will be launching a still wine on the U.S. market, a Chardonnay that will be called simply Ca' del Bosco 1983. It is a wine with great substance aged at length in small oak casks or barriques in the style of the great French wines. It is intended to equal the finest output of the Napa and Sonoma valleys.
